2. Abbey shall notify all future employers of his federal criminal conviction and the Board's prior Order revoking and later reinstating his Kansas license.

3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.
